It is with profound sadness we announce the passing of Aaron Joshua Perks, a beloved and cherished son, brother, uncle, and friend, on May 15, 2020 in Oklahoma City, OK at the age of 35 years, 9 months and 9 days.

His family, friends, and loved ones will gather at 2:00 p.m. Thursday May 21, 2020 at the Bible Baptist Church, where Pastor John Clapp will officiate the Memorial Service. A Graveside Service will follow at the Alva Municipal Cemetery under the direction of Marshall Funeral Home of Alva.

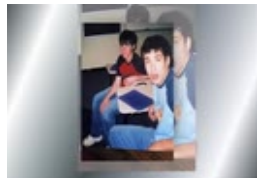

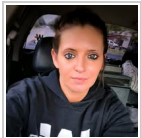
