Alice Angeline "Angie" Pollock, daughter of the late Thomas Abraham and Alice Dorothea (Fox) Wells, was born May 7, 1941, at Salina, Oklahoma, and passed away February 25, 2010, at Oklahoma City at the age of 68 years, 9 months, and 18 days.

Angie, also known as "Mrs. C" by those who knew her, attended school in Kiowa, Kansas. She was united in marriage to Jimmy L. Pollock at Kiowa.
