



## Alvin Henry Barber

November 24, 1943 - March 19, 2016

Funeral services for Alvin Henry Barber will be 11:00 a.m. Thursday, March 24, 2016, at the Alva Church of God with Mark Hornbaker officiating.

Interment will be 3:00 p.m. Thursday in the Shattuck Cemetery under the direction of Marshall Funeral Home of Alva. Alvin Henry Barber, son of the late William Daniel and Viola Pearl (Barber) Barber, was born November 24, 1943, at Alva, Oklahoma, and passed away March 19, 2016, at Oklahoma City, at the age of 72 years, 3 months, and 26 days. Al attended Waynoka Schools. He worked summers on harvest crews and worked winters in the Denver area. He then worked in highway construction mainly in the Texas Panhandle. On September 17, 1963, he was united in marriage to Iva Ann Akers at Dumas, Texas. He worked in a locker plant and three different grocery stores before opening Al's Quickstop in Shattuck, which he operated from 1971 to 1976. He farmed and ranched in the Shattuck area until his retirement in 2006. He enjoyed feeding cattle with Clifford, boating, hunting, and fishing. He also liked running the brush beater behind his Kubota tractor. His family was very important to him and he enjoyed playing dominos and making homemade pizza and bierocks with his grandchildren. Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by two brothers, Clifford Barber and Lester Barber; and two sisters, Mildred Moore and Velma Dittman. Al is survived by his wife, Iva Ann, of Shattuck; two children, Sue Lynn Hornbaker and husband, Dave, of Hutchinson, Kansas and Clifford Barber and wife, Robin, of Shattuck and their children, Micheal and Melissa Atkinson and their children, Kailen and Teddy,

of Arizona, and Matt and Shea Baker of Ft.
