Cecilia Kay Dunkin, daughter of the late Frank E. and Lois V. (Crandall) Morefield, was born September 30, 1949, in Norman, Oklahoma, and passed away May 14, 2020, at Alva, at the age of 70 years, 5 months, and 14 days.

Cecie graduated from Alva High School with the Class of 1967. She then attended the University of Oklahoma and graduated in 1972 with a degree in Interior Design. She was a member of the Theta Gamma Chapter of Delta Delta Delta sorority. She was united in marriage to Pat Parkhurst.

She worked for Evelyn Kamas at the ETC Shoppe for 15 years. In May, 1985, she was united in marriage to Rodney Dunkin in Alva. She owned the Finishing Touch Interior Design Studio. She also catered for many years for social events around the Alva area.
