Charles Mason "Buck" Ingraham, son of the late Charles Frederick and Jane (Million) Ingraham, was born January 24, 1921, in Clayton, New Mexico, and passed away June 3, 2006, at Enid, Oklahoma, at the age of 88 years, 4 months, and 9 days.
