Clinton Ray Barham, son of the late Charles Raymond and Calla Faye (Taylor) Barham, was born October 16, 1935, at Elk City, and passed away August 7, 2024, at Alva, at the age of 88 years, 9 months, and 22 days.

Clinton was raised in Elk City where he graduated from Merritt High School with the Class of 1954. He attended a semester of college at Oklahoma A & M. On October 11, 1958, he was united in marriage to Gradie Colene Sparks at Kentucky Avenue Baptist Church in Oklahoma City. They made their home in Elk City where he farmed and ranched his entire life. They raised their children, Cullen and Lizabeth on their family farm.

He was a member of the First Baptist Church in Elk City until 2013, when he transferred his membership to First Baptist Church in Alva. He was a lifetime member and Senator of the Jaycees International. Clinton was an avid reader, enjoyed playing the piano and was in the Church Choir.

Besides his parents, Charles and Calla, he was preceded in death by his wife of 65 years, Colene; his son, Cullen Barham; and his son-in-law, Larry Richey.
