Daisy attended grade school at Walnut Grove, Mid Valley, and Red Bird, and then Northwestern High School.

On July 22, 1934, Daisy was united in marriage to Orvel Ray McGolden at the Dacoma Church of God parsonage. Daisy was a member of the Church of God where she served as a Sunday School teacher, youth leader, church Treasurer, and song leader. She was also very active in mission work, sang for many funerals, and read her Bible every day.
