Darrell Dean Wiersig, son of the late Harold and Frances Lois (Forest) Wiersig, was born January 26, 1934, in Woods County, Oklahoma, and passed away July 17, 2015, at Anthony, Kansas, at the age of 81 years, 5 months, and 21 days.

Darrell attended North Eagle and Horace Mann schools before graduating from Alva High School in 1953. He also attended Northwestern Oklahoma State University. While attending Northwestern, Darrell was a member of the Gymnastic Team and Swimming and Diving Team. He was united in marriage to ViAnn Vincent on February 14, 1956, in Wichita, Kansas. Darrell later married Phyllis Holbrook on October 17, 1996.

Darrell was a past member of the First Christian Church, Alva Golf and Country Club, and a current member of the Loyal Order of Moose, Alva Lodge 2100. He served on the Alva School Board and was a member of the 45th Infantry Division of the National Guard. Darrell enjoyed golfing and motorcycling.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by a son, Ricky Darren Wiersig; and a brother, Bobby Joe Wiersig.
