Dixie Dollie Clemence, daughter of the late Jerry Edward and Grace Lillian (Davidson) Beagley, was born September 27, 1934, in Woods County, Oklahoma, and passed away July 20, 2018, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, at the age of 83 years, 9 months, and 23 days.

Dixie attended Freedom School and graduated with the Class of 1952. On June 7, 1952, she was united in marriage to Merle Dean Clemence at Waynoka. They lived in Waynoka until they moved to their home east of town a few years ago.

Dixie was given the gift of hospitality, always welcoming people into her home and making sure they were not hungry.
