Dixie Lee Ewbank, daughter of the late Alva Orvil and Sarah Ann (Wright) Weaver, was born Nov. 9, 1915, in Amity, Mo. and passed away October 11, 2012, at Heritage Manor of Mooreland, at the age of 96 years, 11 months, and 2 days. They moved to Oklahoma when she was 4 years old. She attended Country Grade School and Waynoka High School.

On December 15, 1933, she married Chester Cleckner. After his death she attended Enid Business School. Dixie worked at Integris Bass Baptist Health Center and St. Mary&s Regional Medical Center in the administrative department. After her retirement, Dixie married Ray Ewbank. In 1983, she moved to Waynoka where she volunteered at the hospital and the library. She was a member of Waynoka First Baptist Church where she taught Sunday School and was W.M.U. Director.
