Don was involved in coaching Jen and Brad's teams, even youth soccer and girls T-ball. He faithfully attended all the kids' events, basketball, cheerleading, band, and vocal. Later in life, Don found great joy in playing golf with the noon group.

After retirement, Don and Donna took many road trips together. Their favorite trip was in the summer of 2019. They cruised the Alaskan coast as a whole family. Memories that will last a lifetime were made.

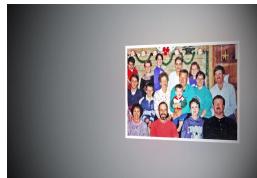
