



Donald Eugene Kilmer

March 7, 1947 - December 19, 2015

Interment services will be held at the Alva Municipal Cemetery 11:00 a.m. Thursday, Dec. 31, 2015. A memorial service is scheduled for Wednesday, Dec. 30 at 10:30 a.m. at South Yukon Church of Christ, Yukon, Oklahoma. Don Eugene Kilmer was born March 7, 1947, in Alva, Okla., to Lauren E. "Bud" and Virginia (Andrews) Kilmer. After graduating from Alva High School in 1965, Don attended Northwestern State College (now Northwestern Oklahoma State University) where he played football and received an accounting degree in 1970. He achieved his Oklahoma Insurance License and Oklahoma Securities License as soon as he was age-eligible. During college he became a member of the Oklahoma National Guard, 45th Infantry Division. Following graduation from college, Don became a Certified Public Accountant. He began working for Arthur Andersen and Co. in Oklahoma City and later worked for ProChemco in Amarillo, Texas; American Cattle Feeders (Gruver, Texas, and Clovis, New Mexico); Mustang Fuel in Oklahoma City; and the RAM Group in Oklahoma City. For the last several years of his professional life he was owner/operator of D&K Accounting in Yukon. He also was an independent broker of life insurance and investments for many years. Don was an active church member through his life and most recently at the South Yukon Church of Christ. He loved football, car racing and gardening. He was a dedicated fan of the Alva Goldbugs, the Northwestern OSU Rangers, the OSU Cowboys and any sport in which his grandsons were involved. He is preceded in death by his parents, Lauren "Bud" Kilmer and Virginia (Andrews)

Kilmer. He is survived by his son, Scott, and wife, Wendy, and their children, Casen and Keaton of Abilene, Texas; his brother Dean Kilmer and wife, Karen; his sister Kay Ann (Kilmer) Lemen and husband, Jeff; nieces, nephews and a host of cousins and lifelong friends.
