Dora Jean, daughter of Frank Alfred and Mary Jane (Sims) Bergen, was born January 18, 1938, at Alva and passed away at her home in Oklahoma City August 2, 2024, at the age of 86 years.

Dora was raised at Avard and graduated from Avard High School in 1956. She attended Beaches Beauty College in Enid in 1957, and Fort Smith Cosmetology School in Fort Smith, Arkansas in 1958. On October 3, 1958, she was united in marriage to Sgt. Harold William Pirtle, Sr. of Tennessee. To this union Reba Sue was born in 1958 and Harold William, Jr. in 1963. She went to school for porcelain doll making and received achievements in 1989 and 1990.
