



Dorothy Lee Ashton

Funeral services for Dorothy Lee Ashton will be 2:00 p.m. Thursday, December 15, 2022, at the Alva First Baptist Church with Pastor Chris Ruwaldt officiating. Interment will be in the Waynoka Cemetery under the direction of Marshall Funeral Home of Alva. There will be a visitation with the family present from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. Wednesday evening.

Dorothy Lee Ashton, daughter of the late William Cary and Cora Rose (Corbin) Crusinbery, was born September 22, 1932, on the family farm in Woods County, Oklahoma, and passed away December 11, 2022, in Alva, Oklahoma, at the age of 90 years, 2 months, and 19 days.

Dorothy attended Twin Oaks School then attended Waynoka High School. On March 2, 1951, she was united in marriage to Paul Wayne Ashton at the First Christian Church in Alva, Oklahoma. She and Paul lived on a farm near where she was born and raised southeast of Waynoka where they farmed and ranched most of their lives.

Dorothy was baptized in the Waynoka First Baptist Church and later moved her membership to the Alva First Baptist Church. She enjoyed reading, bowling and playing cards. She enjoyed baking and was known for having some of the best cinnamon rolls in the country.
