



Dorothy Angela "Angie" Reid

May 27, 1946 - September 22, 2024

Funeral Mass for Angie Reid will be 10:00 a.m. Saturday, September 28, 2024 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church. Burial will follow in the Sacred Heart Catholic Cemetery under the direction of Marshall Funeral Home. There will be a Rosary held at 7:00 p.m. Friday at the Marshall Funeral Home Chapel.

Dorothy Angela (Isenbart) Reid, better known as Angie, was born May 27, 1946, in Alva to parents Fredrick Joseph and Marie Ann (Ney) Isenbart. She passed away peacefully September 22, 2024, leaving behind a legacy of love, wisdom, and faith.

Angie graduated from Alva High School and attended St. Mary of the Plains College and NWOSU, graduating with her Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Education. In 1968, she married Tom Reid at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Alva, officiated by her uncle Monsignor A.A. Isenbart. After 3 months living in southern Italy where Tom was stationed in the Air Force, they returned to Annapolis, Maryland, where she first began teaching.

Tom and Angie moved to Dodge City, Kansas, where they were public school educators and raised their family from 1970-2002. They also lived and worked in Alva for several years in the 1980's, in farming and education, and retired to the Reid family home in 2002.

Angie dedicated her life to education, inspiring countless students as an English teacher in Maryland, Dodge City, and Alva. Her passion for her family, literature and language was matched only by her unwavering commitment to her faith as a lifelong member of the Catholic Church, attending Sacred Heart Church in Alva and Sacred Heart Cathedral in Dodge City. She was the organist for many years in Alva, and has been a longtime member of the Altar Society and the Beta Sigma Phi sorority, Xi Gamma Nu local chapter.

Besides her parents, Fred and Marie, she was preceded in death by her husband of over 55 years, Tom Reid.

She is survived by her siblings, Carolyn Roberts and husband, Boyd, of Celeste, Texas, Fred Isenbart and wife, Lana, of Alva, Ron Isenbart and wife, JoAnn, of Alva, Deanna Smith and husband, Tim, of Broken Arrow, and Connie Corral and husband, John, of Broken Arrow; her eldest son, R.T. Reid and wife, Michelle, of Dodge City, Kansas, and grandchildren, Ryan and wife, Holly, Thane and Bex, and great grandchildren, Claire and Emma; her second son, Eric J. Reid and Megan Maciel of Olathe, Kansas, and grandchildren Quinn and Callum; and her only daughter, Shannon Reid and husband, Todd Abronowitz, of Wylie, Texas, and grandchildren, Madeleine, Tom, Ivy, and Theo; as well as numerous other relatives and friends.

Angela's gentle spirit, kind heart, and dedication to her community will be deeply missed by all who knew her. She leaves behind a family who adored her and a community that cherished her contributions.
