Earlene (Klick) Moser, daughter of the late Earl Nathan and Ruby Viola (Schwindt) Klick, was born September 24, 1930, west of Carmen on the family farm, and passed away June 4, 2023, at Fairview, at the age of 92 years, 8 months, and 10 days.
