Eldor Erich Stelling, son of John and Lina (Schroeder) Stelling, was born November 5, 1917, at Frohna, Missouri, and passed away July 17, 2010, at Alva, Oklahoma, at the age of 92 years, 8 months, and 12 days.

Eldor attended school at Point Rest, Missouri. In 1945, he moved to Alva and started working for Alva Farmer's Co-op shortly thereafter.
