Elmer Edwin Bartlett, son of the late Edwin Theodore and Mary Ann (Ashbrook) Bartlett, was born June 20, 1931, at Blackwell, Oklahoma, and passed away November 22, 2008, at Wichita, Kansas, at the age of 77 years, 5 months, and 2 days.

After Sarge graduated from the Palestine, Texas High School, he enlisted in the Air Force and later enlisted in the United States Marine Corps. He served in Korea as a diesel mechanic and was later stationed at Camp Pendleton until his retirement. After his service he moved to Hayesville, Kansas.

He was a member of the Southern Baptist Church. He was also a member of the American Legion in Mulvane, Kansas, the Veterans of Foreign Wars in Haysville, Kansas, and a life member of DAV in Wichita, Kansas.
