



## Everett Bryan Powers

March 30, 1968 - June 20, 2025

Bryan Powers was born to Eldon and Bobbie Jene (Ridgway) Powers in Kiowa, Kansas, on March 30, 1968, and went to his heavenly home on June 20, 2025, surrounded by family in Alva, after bravely fighting pancreatic cancer for the past four years. He passed away at the age of 57 years, 2 months, and 21 days.

Bryan graduated from Freedom High School in 1986, where he was active in 4-H, FFA, and football. When he was a senior, he was an All-Star player on the 8-man football team. He also earned a State Farmers Degree in FFA. After graduation, he attended Oklahoma University for 3 semesters.

Bryan was an avid fan of all Oklahoma sports, especially football and softball. Bryan was a very compassionate and caring man who would do anything and everything for anyone who needed help. He was always surrounded by his fur babies anytime he was home, cuddling up with him whenever he was in his favorite chair. He was our go-to guy for forgotten dates of memories.

Bryan started working in the Aeronautics Industry in 1989 for Kinzie's, as Director of Sales and Marketing which sold to Plane Plastics in 2000, where he continued to work until 2007. He then went to work for PAST (Premier Aeronautics Service and Technology.) He remained as Director of Sales and Marketing in each place of employment, working there until his passing, even when not feeling up to par. In all these work places he continued to maintain his title of Director of Sales and Marketing, working in the aeronautics industry for 37 years.

Bryan is survived by his mother, Bobbie Jene (Ridgway) Powers of Alva; his brother, Victor Powers and his wife, Carol, of Alva; his special Aunt Deanna and Uncle Gene Jackson of Alva; his uncles, Lynn Ridgway and wife, Julie, of Edmond, Randy Ridgway and wife, Ella, of Enid, Merle Ridgway and wife, Diann, of Alva, and Larry Powers and wife, Rena, of Woodward.
