



Gail Lynn Frey

Gail Lynn Frey, only child of the late Oliver Francis and Leota Lula (Lieurance) Frey, was born June 20, 1943, at Alva, and passed away January 18, 2021, at Enid at the age of 77 years, 6 months, and 29 days.

Gail attended school and graduated from Carmen High School. He was united in marriage to Nancy Lee Jackson and together they had three children: Dale, Dana, and Dian. They made their home in the Carmen area where they raised their family. He later married Teresa Stevens. He lived a short time in Kingfisher before returning to the farm where he lived until his passing.

He was a member of the First Baptist Church in Carmen. Gail worked for Pioneer Telephone as a manager and retired after 38 years. He was a member of the Northwest Beekeepers Association, enjoyed fishing, gardening, woodworking, treasure hunting, and was a beekeeper.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by his wife, Teresa.

Gail is survived by his children, Dale Frey and his wife, Melinda, of Oklahoma City, Dana Ford and her husband, Derek, of Woodward, Dian Frey of Carmen, Debbie Brown of Booker, Texas; stepchildren, Mike Nugent and his wife, Kayla, of Stillwater, and Jennifer Stoner and her husband, Shawn, of Arkansas City, Kansas; nineteen grandchildren; twenty-nine great grandchildren; other relatives and friends.
