Georgiana F. Ramy, daughter of the late George and Della Gisson, was born April 1, 1933, at Alva, Oklahoma, and passed away September 28, 2022, in Oklahoma City, at the age of 89 years, 5 months, and 27 days.

Georgie was raised in the Alva area where her parents ran a grocery store and she attended the Catholic school. On July 30, 1955, she was united in marriage to Charles J. Ramy in Mankato, Minnesota, where they made their home until moving to Fairfax, Minnesota, in 1959. While living in Fairfax, she worked at the elevator, then in 1969 the family purchased the Alva Bowling Alley and moved to Alva.

Georgie loved playing the piano and organ. For many years she played the organ at the Alva Sacred Heart Catholic Church. Bowling, golf, and bridge were other activities she also enjoyed.

She was preceded in death by her father, George, her mother, Della, her husband, Charles, and one infant son, Ronald.

Georgie is survived by one daughter, Roberta “Bertie” Ramy of Oklahoma City; four sons, Thomas Ramy and wife, Sherry, of Alva, Donald Ramy of Oklahoma City, Mark Ramy and wife, Rita, of Oklahoma City, and John Ramy of Oklahoma City; three grandchildren; two great grandchildren; other relatives and friends.

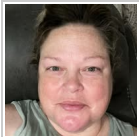
