Gilbert Gum, son of the late Leonard Glen and Lillie (Fisher) Gum, was born July 27, 1937, in Woods County, Oklahoma, and passed away June 19, 2012, at Enid, Oklahoma, at the age of 74 years, 10 months, and 22 days.

Gilbert attended the Avard and Rose Valley Schools before graduating from Waynoka High School. On June 6, 1958, he was united in marriage to Mildred Wilcox. He worked as a farmer/rancher and a Waynoka Police officer before working as a custodian and bus driver for the Waynoka Schools.
