Ila Orpha, daughter of Raymond Newton and Olive Marguerite (Schlarb) Harmon, was born September 25, 1926, on the homestead south of Bouse Junction and she passed away September 18, 2025, at Alva, at the age of 98 years, 11 months, and 24 days.

Ila was raised with her sisters on the family homestead south of Bouse Junction. On July 14, 1943, she was united in marriage to Delfred Inman at Alva. To this union four children were born: Darral, Judy, Raymond, and Tim. They made their home in Waynoka for several years where they raised their family before moving to Madill. They later returned to a farm they purchased east of Bouse Junction.

She was a member of the Church of Christ. Ila worked at the Fairview Fellowship Home for 20+ years. She moved to Alva in 2017 where she has lived until her passing. She enjoyed quilting, crocheting, working puzzles, and

spoiling her grandchildren. Ila also loved watching baseball and golf.

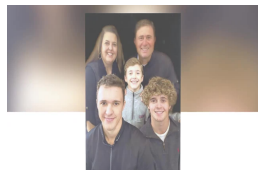
