She attended grade school at Danville and high school at Harper, Kansas where she moved with her parents in 1925. On September 25, 1926, she and Vernon M. Henderson were married at Anthony, Kansas, and moved to Paoli, Colorado. To this union two children were born: Neal Cleon in 1927 and Rosalie Rae in 1929.
