Isla F. Hada, daughter of the late Wesley Alexander Copeland and Edith Naomi (Chatham) Copeland, was born February 12, 1948, in Topeka, Kansas, and passed away May 24, 2022, in Oklahoma City, at the age of 74 years, 3 months, and 12 days.

Isla graduated from Topeka High School. She then attended Miltonvale Wesleyan College and received her bachelor's degree from Marion College (Now Indiana Wesleyan University). Later, she went on to receive her master's degree from Northwestern Oklahoma State University. On June 27, 1970, she was united in marriage to Roger Leon Hada in Topeka, Kansas.

They lived a couple of places before moving to Alva in 1976. She taught in an elementary classroom, mostly 5th grade at Lincoln Elementary here in Alva, for 30 plus years!

Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by one sister, Jane Greene.

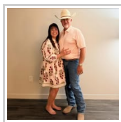
