James Walter "Jim" Faurot, son of the late Walter Woods and Lena Star (Middleton) Faurot, was born August 27, 1928 at Waynoka, Oklahoma, and passed away December 6, 2007 at Muskogee, Oklahoma, at the age of 79 years, 3 months, and 9 days.

After Jim graduated from Waynoka High School, he attended Northwestern State College in Alva. Jim served in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict and earned the U.N. Service Medal, the Combat Infantry Badge, and the Korean Service Medal with one Bronze Star.

On March 10, 1951, he was united in marriage to Billie Brown at his parents country home. He worked as a clerk and mail carrier at the Waynoka Post office until 1982 when he retired after 35 years of service. He also raised thousands of turkey over many years.

He was a member of the United Methodist Church. As an active member of the Waynoka American Legion Post, he called Bingo and placed flags on veteran's graves for many years. He loved to fish for bass and hunt quail with his favorite dog. He also collected stamps.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by one brother, Gene Faurot; and two grandchildren, Keith Inman and Shayla Faurot.

Jim is survived by his wife, Billie, of Muskogee; two sons, Steve Allen Faurot and his wife, Shelley, of Skiatook, Oklahoma, and Thomas James Faurot and his wife, Kimberly, of Denver, Colorado; and one daughter, Linda Gail Faurot of Muskogee, Oklahoma.
