Jaunita Rose Passwaters, daughter of the late Tully and Mary Irene (Reihm) Hall, was born August 17, 1918, near Medford, Oklahoma, and passed away March 27, 2009, at Beadles Nursing Home in Alva, Oklahoma, at the age of 90 years, 7 months, and 10 days.

Jaunita attended rural school near Galena, then Northwestern Normal School in Alva. She then graduated from Enid Beauty School. On May 14, 1939, she was united in marriage to Ray Thomas Passwaters at her parents home. They lived in Waynoka where she worked as a beautician and a waitress, worked for Doc Wright, and then worked as a Nurse's Aide until her retirement.
