Jerry Dwayne Warrington, son of the late Harry Harrison and Elinor Pauline (Coggins) Warrington, was born June 4, 1949, at the Achenbach Memorial Hospital in Hardtner, Kansas, and passed away in his home August 20, 2023, in Hutchinson, Kansas, at the age of 74 years, 2 months, and 16 days.

Jerry graduated from Nickerson High School with the Class of 1968. After graduation, he joined and proudly served in the United States Navy. On April 12, 1975, he married his bride Annette M Toland at the Congregational Church in Kiowa. They lived in Garden City, St. John and Medicine Lodge, Kansas, before moving to Hutchinson, Kansas, where they lived for the last 36 years. He worked as a heavy equipment mechanic most of his life for places such as Massey Ferguson and Reno County. He also worked as a truck driver, cabinet builder, and on custom wheat and corn harvests.

He enjoyed fishing, tinkering in his shop, hunting, woodworking and cruising the gyp hills. Most of all, he loved spending time with family, friends, and Lil Maggie Sue.

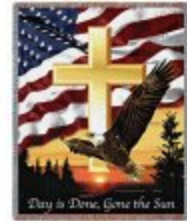
