



John Gordon Hibbs

Funeral services for John Gordon Hibbs will be 1:00 p.m. Wednesday, December 20, 2023, at the Waynoka First Baptist Church with Reverend David Shaw and Pastor Thure Tolson officiating. Interment will be in the Liberty Cemetery under the direction of Marshall Funeral Home of Waynoka.

John Gordon Hibbs, son of the late Allen Clayton and Elsie Mae (Parsons) Hibbs, was born November 15, 1932, in Paden, Oklahoma, and passed away December 14, 2023, in Moore, Oklahoma, at the age of 91 years and 29 days.

John attended school at Okemah and later obtained his GED. On January 17, 1951, he entered the United States Army and served in the Korean War. He was honorably discharged January 16, 1953.

On October 28, 1954, he was united in marriage to Frances Marie Butler. They moved to Moore, Oklahoma in 1962 and he drove a Semi for Transcon Lines. He drove a truck for about 30 years. When he retired from driving, They bought the American Printing and Binding, Inc., which they operated until 1992. They later leased several trucks to a trucking company where he worked as a driver. They moved to the farm south of Waynoka in 1995 to care for family.

John was a member of the Waynoka First Baptist Church. He always had a

pocket full of candy which he gave out for the price of a hug. He was a very active past member of Waynoka Masonic Lodge #422, and served as District Deputy for several years and was currently a member of the Seiling Lodge.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Frances; six brothers, Albert, Glen, Lloyd, Allen, George, and Carrol Hibbs; one sister, Joyce; and one of his bonus kid, Sandra Scott Lee.

John is survived by one son, John Gordon, Hibbs, Jr.; three daughters Sharon Kaye Buerger and husband, Mike, of Mustang, Cheryl Ann Lambert of Moore, and Karon Marie Isbell, of Moore; and one sister, Betty Foster, of Guthrie.

Also surviving are five grandchildren, Rick Newcomb and wife, Jada, of New Castle, Michael Buerger of Oklahoma City, Beth Dean and husband, Nick, of Choctaw, Harley William Isbell of Oklahoma City, and Shannon Finley and husband, Blaine, of Edmond; six great grandchildren, Alyssa Newcomb, Sirius Isbell, Payton Finley, Colton Finley, Landon Dean, Scotlynn Dean, and Deklon Dean; three bonus kids, Ty Jones, Debbie Doss Pickett, and Melinda Ditzen; a special friend, Lois Graff; other relatives and friends.
