Julie Ann Buckley, daughter of the late Harvey M. and Velma (Cantrell) Browning, was born June 28, 1950, at Winslow, Arizona, and passed away April 29, 2008, at Alva, Oklahoma, at the age of 57 years, 10 months, and 1 day.

Julie graduated from Alva High School and received degrees in Home Economics and Social Work from Northwestern Oklahoma State University.
