Kay Lynn Hood, daughter of the late William Alfred and Margaret Luella (Miller) Cook, was born December 22, 1942, at Alva, Oklahoma, and passed away January 15, 2013, at Alva, Oklahoma, at the age of 70 years and 23 days.

Kay attended the Lutheran School in Alva and graduated from Alva High School with the Class of 1960. On July 28, 1960, she was united in marriage to Donald Lee Hood at Alva, Oklahoma. She received her Bachelor's degree from OCLA in 1970, and earned her Master of Environmental Science from Oklahoma University in 1972. She taught school at Cement High School, Rush Springs High School, Chickasha Middle School and Chickasha High school for a total of 30 years, retiring in 2003.

She was baptized and confirmed in the Zion Lutheran Church where she was a member before moving away in 1966. She then became a member of the Holy Name Catholic Church in Chickasha from 1973 until she moved back to Alva in 2003, at which time she rejoined the Zion Lutheran Church.

Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Don; and one son, Christopher Hood.
