Kenneth Ray, son of the late Lloyd Chester and Florence Miranda (Mackey) Percival, was born December 26, 1939, at Hopeton and passed away peacefully June 28, 2025, at Enid at the age of 85 years, 6 months, and 2 days.

Kenneth was raised with his brothers in the Hopeton area, graduating from Dacoma High School. In August of 1961, he was united in marriage to Dora Mae Kinney and together they had two daughters, Kathy and Lisa. They made their home in Enid where he worked for 43 years as an aircraft mechanic at Vance Airforce Base until his retirement in 2001. On March 22, 1996, he was united in marriage to Donna Jo Hiskett in Enid.

He was an avid hunter, fisherman, and golfer. He was a member of the Amateur Trap Shooters Association and won many trophies over the years. Kenneth was also a member of the Elks Lodge and was involved in the organizing of the Grand National Quail Hunt.
