Laura Jean Barker, daughter of the late Claud Edward and Rella Olivia (Nauerth) Guyer, was born December 28, 1927, in Woodward County, Oklahoma, and passed away January 22, 2020, at Edmond, Oklahoma, at the age of 92 years and 25 days.

Jean attended Pleasant Hill School through the 8th grade and graduated from Waynoka High School. On July 14, 1948, she was united in marriage to Teddie Gene Barker in Cherokee. She worked as an operator for the Waynoka telephone system, then at E.P. Clapper Hospital. She retired from her position as a clerk at the Santa Fe Railroad depot.

She was a member of the Northside Church of Christ and the Waynoka Historical Society. She enjoyed traveling, quilting and completing cross stitch projects. She also enjoyed helping deliver Meals on Wheels in Waynoka.

Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by two siblings, Esther Redgate and Charles Guyer.
