Leon Will Perfect was born to Eldon and Vera Mae (Sweeney) Perfect on December 3, 1931 at Humansville, Missouri. He departed this life on March 27, 2014, at the age of 82. Leon and his family moved from Missouri to Alva, Oklahoma, when he was about 10 years of age. He was baptized on April 21, 1935, and was a member of the Zion Lutheran Church. Leon attended school in Alva and graduated from Alva High School with the class of 1949. Leon proudly enlisted with the 45th Infantry Division, Signal Corp. of the United States Army and served in Korea from 1950 to 1951. After returning to Alva, he attended Northwestern State College. On December 19, 1954, Leon was married to Verna Lee Wilson at the Zion Lutheran Church in Alva. This union was blessed with two children, LeAnn Marie and Jerry Leon. Leon worked for OG&E for 31 plus years, retiring in 1988. He enjoyed golfing, fishing, hunting, playing cards, and watching sports. One of his greatest pleasures was watching his grandchildren play sports. He was preceded in death by his parents, Eldon and Vera Mae Perfect; two brothers, identical twin Loren John and younger brother, David Lee; and sister-in-law, Georgia Wallace Perfect.
