Leona Dee Stonehocker, daughter of the late George Jackson and Iva Leona (Marks) Leatherman, was born June 7, 1945, at Alva, Oklahoma, and passed away August 19, 2017, at Fairview, Oklahoma, at the age of 72 years, 2 months, and 12 days.

Dee graduated from Alva High School with the class of 1963. She attended beauty school in Enid for a time. On September 18, 1971, she was united in marriage to Jacob Byron "J.B." Stonehocker at Alva. They lived in many places while her husband worked in the oilfield. She settled in Carmen in the mid 90's.

Dee was very community minded and was a regular attender at the Carmen Chamber of Commerce meetings. She enjoyed helping with the annual Easter Egg Hunt and many other events. In her later years she supported the veterans with craft kits.
