Louis Henry Schupbach, son of the late Ralph Abraham and Fern Weibke Elise (Otte) Schupbach, was born March 19, 1943, at Hardtner, Kansas, and passed away June 30, 2014, at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, at the age of 71 years, 3 months, and 11 days.

Louis attended the Lutheran School through the 8th grade and graduated from Alva High School. He then received his degree in agriculture from Oklahoma State University where he was a member of Farmhouse Fraternity. He served in the Oklahoma National Guard.

On September 26, 1965, he was united in marriage to Janis Grace Russell at Aline, Oklahoma. They made their home on the farm west of Alva where he farmed and ranched.

He was a member of the Zion Lutheran Church, the Oklahoma Wheat Growers where he had served as President and the Salt Fork Craftsmen, a black smithing club. He was a very talented musician who always played background music at the Lutheran chicken and noodle dinners. He enjoyed reading, metal detecting, and was an avid OSU fan. His family was always very important to him and they often traveled together.

Louis is survived by his wife, Janis, of Alva; two daughters, Joelle Randall and

husband, J. P., of Alva, and Gina Vandruff and husband, Kyle, of Cashion; one son, Ryan Schupbach and wife, Nhi, of Owasso; one sister, Suzanne Pralle and husband, Darrell, of Enid; six grandchildren, Whitney Randall, Phillip Randall, Austin Vandruff, Jackson Vandruff, Aiden Schupbach, and Liam Schupbach; his aunt, Helen Beisel, of Burlington; other relatives and many friends.
