



## Lula McGuire

May 5, 1919 - May 11, 2011

Funeral services for Lula Lee McGuire will be 10:00 a.m. Thursday, May 19, 2011, at the Alva Friends Church with Pastor Mark McDonald officiating. Interment will be in the Alva Municipal Cemetery under the direction of Marshall Funeral Home of Alva.

Lula Lee McGuire, daughter of the late William James and Katherine Jo (Johnston) Rea, was born May 5, 1919, in Capron, Oklahoma, and passed away May 11, 2011, at Eufaula, Oklahoma, at the age of 92 years and 6 days. Lula graduated from Capron High School with the Class of 1936 and attended Northwestern State Teachers College. On February 10, 1938, she was united in marriage to Francis Ray McGuire at Alva, Oklahoma. She worked as a receptionist in a Doctor's office for 12 years, then served as Deputy City Clerk for the City of Alva. She retired in 1989 after 25 years of service for the City. She was a member of the Alva Friends Church, BPW, and VFW Ladies Auxiliary. She enjoyed gardening and knitting.
