



Margaret "Mickey" Martha Kletke

September 25, 1918 - July 30, 2015

Visitation with the family for Margaret "Mickey" Martha Kletke will be held at 11:30 a.m., Monday, August 3, 2015, in the Fellowship Hall at the Zion Lutheran Church in Alva. Interment will be in the Zion Lutheran Cemetery under the direction of Marshall Funeral Home.

Mickey was born at the Rauh family homestead southeast of Alva on September 25, 1918, to Alvin A. and Marie W. (Wenninger) Rauh and passed away July 30, 2015, at Alva, Oklahoma, at the age of 96 years, 10 months, and 5 days.

She graduated from Pleasant Valley School and Horace Mann High School. She also attended Northwestern State College. On January 21, 1940, Mickey was married to Roland Henry Kletke. She lived and worked on their farm southeast of Alva until May 2015. They had two sons, James (Jim) Roland Kletke and Douglas (Doug) John Kletke, who were both born in Hardtner, Kansas.

She loved to play the piano and duplicate bridge, golf, cook, work in the garden, knit, and needlepoint. She also enjoyed reading, traveling, and playing cards and board games with her nieces, nephews, and grandchildren. She worked in the Woods County Abstract Office in the 1930's and into the 1950's and played the organ at Zion Lutheran Church for over fifteen years. Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Roland, infant son, Charles; eight brothers and sisters, Edward "Mutt," Everett "Toots," Russell "Pete," Zipporah "Zip," Arthur "Sox," Alvin Jr. "Bud," John "Pistol," and

Esther "Babe,"; and three stepsiblings, Buddy, Verlin, and Lorene Shimp. Mickey is survived by her sons, Jim of Norfolk, Virginia, and Doug of Alva; grandchildren, Pamela, Andrew, Kathryn, and Sydney; great grandchildren, Ian and Mills; numerous nieces and nephews; and good friends, Margaret, Sudha, and Moorthy.
