She taught at Horace Mann Junior High and Palo Duro High School until her retirement in 1985. She moved to Alva, Oklahoma, in 2006.

She enjoyed helping other people in any way she could. She was a dedicated volunteer for Meals on Wheels and prepared income tax returns at H & R Block. She loved her family and always looked for ways to help them. She especially liked buying gifts for everyone on special occasions.

Besides her parents, she was preceded by all of her siblings, including three brothers, Robert Hawkins, Wayne Hawkins, and Charles Eddy Hawkins; and two sisters, Shirley McDonald and Martha Jones, and a special niece, Misty

McDonald.
