Martha Lewis Woolley, daughter of the late Teddy Sturgeon and Verla Dean (Howell) Jones, was born May 9, 1944, at Waynoka, and passed away December 16, 2015, at Enid, at the age of 71 years, 7 months, and 7 days. Martha graduated from Waynoka High School. On November 28, 1964, she was united in marriage to Rick Woolley. She later went on to graduate from Northwestern Oklahoma State University in 1980 with a degree in business administration and accounting.

She worked for Panhandle Eastern for several years, transferring to Lebanon, Tennessee, in 1989. She worked in the Nashville area until moving to Kansas for a few years before returning back to Alva in 1998. Shortly thereafter, she began working for Steve Knox, CPA, until her retirement in April of 2014.
