Mitzi Lou (Woods) Frey, daughter of the late James George and Lela Mae (Evans) Woods, was born May 2, 1935, at her grandparents home in Alva, Oklahoma, and passed away February 22, 2010, at Cordell, Oklahoma, at the age of 74 years, 9 months, and 20 days.
