Monte Wayne Hayes, son of the late Ivan D. and Bette Jane (Boland) Hayes, was born May 5, 1956, at Lincoln, Nebraska, and passed away July 16, 2009, at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, at the age of 53 years, 2 months, and 11 days.

Monte graduated from Enid High School with the Class of 1974. He excelled in football, baseball and weightlifting in school. He attended Northwestern Oklahoma State University before graduating from Oklahoma State University with a degree in engineering. On March 5, 1977, he was united in marriage to Roxie Gay Williams in Enid, Oklahoma. To this union one daughter, Melissa Hayes, was born and he adopted Melissa's brother, Ricky.
