Funeral services for Nathan Tyler Lyon will be 2:00 p.m. Friday, January 9, 2009, at the Waynoka School with Rev. David Shaw and Coach Scott Kysar officiating. On April 15, 1990, "a gift from God," Nathan Tyler Lyon, was born in Seiling, Oklahoma to Tracy Lyon and Stan Lyon of Waynoka, Oklahoma. He was tragically taken from his family on January 4, 2009. Nathan was an exceptional human being, with a big heart and witty sense of humor. He had a passion for football, both playing it and watching it. He was an avid OU football fan. He was a proud Waynoka Railroader and excelled on the football field and received numerous awards for his talent. He loved fishing and hunting with his family, which always turned into a fun competition between them. He loved riding around in his truck and hanging out with his friends. Nathan will be deeply missed by all who knew him. He was preceded in death by an infant brother, Ross Allen; his maternal grandfather, Elmer Ross; his paternal grandparents, Beverly and Grover Lyon; his great grandparents, Bert Woolley, Buster Ross, and Leona Ross.
