



Pauline "Polly" Wentworth Stanley

October 8, 1925 - May 16, 2021

Funeral services for Pauline Stanley will be 10:00 a.m. Thursday, May 20, 2021, at the Carmen Christian Church with Pastor Kirk Board officiating. Burial will follow in the Carmen City Cemetery under the direction of Wentworth Mortuary, LLC. Masks are requested at the service.

Pauline Opal (Young) Wentworth Stanley, daughter of the late Ralph Olen and Rilla Mae (Andrews) Young, was born October 8, 1925, southwest of Aline and passed away May 16, 2021, at Colorado Springs, at the age of 95 years, 7 months, and 8 days.

Polly lived in Aline, Cherokee, Driftwood, and Higgins, Texas, before her family settled in the Carmen area. She graduated from Carmen High School. She was united in marriage to Max Wentworth on September 8, 1946. With this marriage she began her career in the funeral home business. To this union one daughter was born, Paulett. After Max passed away, she continued working as a funeral director until she sold the mortuary and retired in 2007 at the age of 81. On October 5, 1974, Polly married Clark Stanley. For the past year, she has lived in Colorado Springs with her daughter, Paulett.

Polly was a member of the United Methodist Church but attended the Carmen Christian Church for many years. She was a member of the Carmen Historical Organization of Oklahoma and a past member of the Carmen Chamber of

Commerce. She was a trusted funeral director for over 60 years and a wealth of knowledge to her community.

Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by her husbands, Max Wentworth and Clark Stanley; her sister, Marie Tolleson; and her brothers, infant twins and Wayne Young.

Polly is survived by her daughter, Paulett Wentworth of Colorado Springs, Colorado; many other relatives and friends.
