Pearl Marie McMurry, daughter of the late Francis Marion and Myrtle Violet (Moore) Erikson, was born May 30, 1913, on the farm northwest of Alva, Oklahoma, and passed away November 10, 2009, at Alva, Oklahoma, at the age of 96 years, 5 months, and 10 days. Pearl attended school at Faulkner and Blackwell before graduating from Alva High School. She then obtained her teaching certificate from Northwestern Oklahoma State University. On November 23, 1935, she was united in marriage to Don Gaylord McMurry at Judge Glazier's house in Alva. They made their home on their farm northwest of Alva where they farmed and ranched. She also worked at the ASCS Office, Munson Hatchery, and was a substitute teacher at Farry School. She was a member of the Farry Helpers Club and Farry Quilters. She was involved in organizing the first Farry Class Reunion. She liked working with numbers and did the tax returns for her family for many years. Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Don; five brothers, Irish Erikson, William Erikson, Virgil Erikson, Howard Erikson, and F. M. Erikson, Jr.; and four sisters, Opal Kowing, Irene McKenzie, Mabel Kokendoffer, and infant Georgia Erikson; and one infant great grandson, Nicholas Ira Harzman.
