Phillip Lynn Lyon, son of Harley and Gertrude (Cox) Lyon. Phillip was born November 21, 1942 in Alva, Oklahoma and entered eternal life at the age of 83 years, 6 months, and 11 days. Phillip became an active member and was baptized in the Zion Lutheran Church in Alva, Oklahoma.
