



Phillip Allen Murry

September 4, 1942 - June 7, 2019

Memorial services for Phillip Allen Murry will be 2:00 p.m. Thursday, June 13, 2019, at the Zion Lutheran Church with Pastor Aaron Wagoner officiating. A private interment will be held prior to the service under the direction of Marshall Funeral Home of Alva.

Phillip Allen Murry, son of the late James Ivan and Cara Mae (Thompson) Murry, was born September 4, 1942, in Alva, Oklahoma, and passed away June 7, 2019, at his home near Alva, at the age of 76 years, 9 months, and 3 days.

After Phillip graduated from Alva High School he attended Northwestern State College. On February 19, 1960, he was united in marriage to Sandra Rauh at Cherokee, Oklahoma. He worked as a welder for Panhandle Eastern for 35 years, until his retirement in 1997. During the oil boom he worked as a welding inspector for area oil companies. He also farmed, had rentals, raised ostriches, and was a cattleman. He enjoyed taking the grandchildren arrowhead hunting, hunting, and fishing, and taking family trips to Colorado, New Mexico, and Lake Texhoma.

He was a member of the Zion Lutheran Church.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by one great grandson,

Brendan Campbell.
