January 5, 1917 - July 18, 2012

Retta Ann Woolley, daughter of the late Charlie and Mildred (Sweargin) Trammell, was born January 5, 1917, in Woods County, Oklahoma, and passed away July 18, 2012, at Waynoka, Oklahoma, at the age of 95 years, 6 months, and 13 days.

Retta attended rural schools near Waynoka. On December 22, 1934, she was united in marriage to Ralph Floyd Woolley at Waynoka, Oklahoma. She worked as a telephone operator during and after World War II. She then worked at the Waynoka School Cafeteria and Rexall Drug Store until her retirement in 1970.

She was a member of the Waynoka Church of God, the Waynoka Saddle Club, and the Waynoka Senior Citizens. She enjoyed dancing, collecting antique dishes, and spending time with her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren.

Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Ralph; four brothers, Robert, Roy, Lee, and Edsel Trammell; and four sisters, Rosa Lebow, Ruby Milledge, Viola Alexander, and her twin, Reta Snyder.
