Rolos Inman, son of the late Sam and Cora Esther (Hoffman) Inman, was born February 17, 1940, at the family home in Major County, and passed away at his home on September 6, 2015, at the age of 75 years, 6 months, and 19 days. He attended Cheyenne Valley school and graduated there. On January 6, 1963, he was united in marriage to Darlene May Ging at Dacoma, Oklahoma. They made their home at Cheyenne Valley and raised their children, Carla and Marty, on their farm. Rolos attended the Cheyenne Valley Methodist Church. He worked for Major County District #3, retiring after 29 years. He enjoyed playing the steel guitar and played at least five nights a month with his band. Rolos also enjoyed playing horseshoes, fishing, and hunting. He was the president of Lone Star Cemetery for many years.
