Shirley Jean Snow, daughter of the late Charles William and Florence Ethel (Woolley) Like, was born March 13, 1937, and passed away March 12, 2011, at Integris Baptist Medical Center in Oklahoma City, at the age of 73 years, 11 months, and 29 days.
